- Integrate social content using tools/solutions such as Later, Canva, etc.
- Program social platforms including Facebook, Instagram, website, etc.
- Design graphics and creative content
- Research relevant content and topics to be integrated in social platforms, relevant to the Media Strategy
- Pitch segment and content ideas
- Produce monthly newsletters
- Create marketing materials: fliers, yard signs, etc.

No previous experience is needed to apply for the New Media Communications Internship. Candidates should have an interest in marketing, communications, graphic design and/or social media. Candidates will be asked to provide examples of work such as social postings and graphic design.

The successful candidate will be required to complete and pass a background check before being hired.
